VENUE LOCATION

**Laurelwood Earthdog Centre – 42 Col. Williams Lane
south of Bethany, Ontario
(East of Toronto)**

Directions From Toronto area or points west: Take ON-401 east to exit 436 for ON-35/ON-115 towards Lindsay/Peterborough. Follow Hwy 115 north to Porter Road exit towards Victoria Road 32/Bethany. Turn left onto Porter Road. Turn right onto Solanum Way. Turn right onto Col William Lane and take to the end. Cross over the train tracks and follow the event signs.

From Port Hope area or points east: Take ON-401 west to exit 461 for County Road 2. Turn right onto County 2 Rd (signs for County Road 2N/ON-2N). Continue straight onto County 10 Rd/Northumberland County Road 10. Turn left onto King St E/Peterborough County Road 21. Turn right onto Tapley Quarter Line. Turn left onto Fallis Line. (becomes Solanum Way). Turn left onto Col William Lane and take to the end. Cross over the train tracks and follow the event signs.

Come with your border terrier and join in the fun!
